The Australian Quilt



A microchip can easily be hidden in a quilt, it is the size of a grain of rice and it is advisable to place it somewhere in the middle of the quilt, mark it with a pin prior to quilting, although these are made to withstand a huge amount of movement, I believe that a sewing machine needle will destroy it.

It can withstand all normal washing up to 51 degrees celcius and is impervious to all washing chemicals.

Registering your quilt with The AQR will help in identifying your quilt a unique number is allocated to each quilt and ownership can be transfered. It is useful as well for insurance purposes.

The chip can be read by scanners that are in your local council, vet clinic and some police stations.

A double data base is set up at AQR, on that holds the information on a computer and an actual “physical” one in a filing cabinet.
